What's On

- The Show provides Historical Societies and re-enactments through various forces, from several eras and theatres during the period of 1939-45. From Airmen to Infantry, the Victory Show opens a window in time to the fabulous 1940's
- The Victory Show provides entertainment for the whole family as the 100-acre farmland is transformed back in time with groups of re-enactors, a battle re-enactment, static war planes, memorabilia and artillery displays.
- The Show also consists of an air display of wartime aircraft such as the Spitfire, P51-Mustang, Hawker Hurricane and many more!

Schools Day Experience

4th September 2026

- This year the school's educational day will be held on **Friday 4th September 2026.**
- The School's Day will be both educational and enjoyable and will give children and teachers the opportunity to experience what The Victory Show has to offer.
- A short history lesson will be presented to school groups attending.
- An area will be provided for children and their teachers to obtain a health & safety briefing upon arrival.
- Ample opportunities for question-and-answer sessions with the many re-enactment groups.



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The Experience

 - Trenches and the uniforms they wore.
 - Displays of period vehicles including artillery and soft skinned vehicles.
 - Static wartime aircraft and get close to life size replicas of British fighter planes.
 - Experience sitting inside a WWII aircraft (subject to availability and serviceability)!

While at the Show

- The show organisers encourage children and their teachers to dress in period costume to help re-create the 1940's theme with sensible footwear. There will be a prize for the most authentic 1940's child and teacher.
- Please be aware that newspaper reporters and photographers may be in attendance. **If any child / teacher does not want to be photographed, please advise a member of the Victory Show Crew upon arrival.**
- Each school should have relevant staffing levels to supervise the children while on site.
- All schools are welcome to arrive from **10am – 5pm**, however **MUST** advise on expected time of arrival and departure for traffic controls to be put in place, via your booking form.
- Fast food refreshments may be available on site, however children are welcome to bring along a packed lunch / drink and snack if required. It is advisable that all children bring along a water bottle to keep hydrated and we kindly request that all rubbish is disposed of in the allocated litter bins within the showground.
